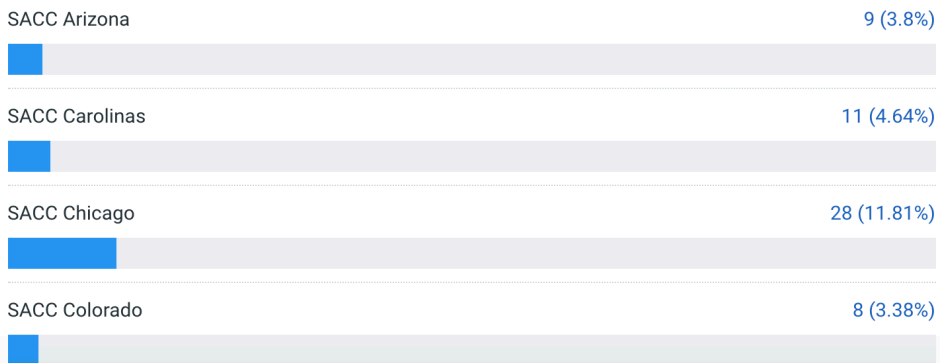

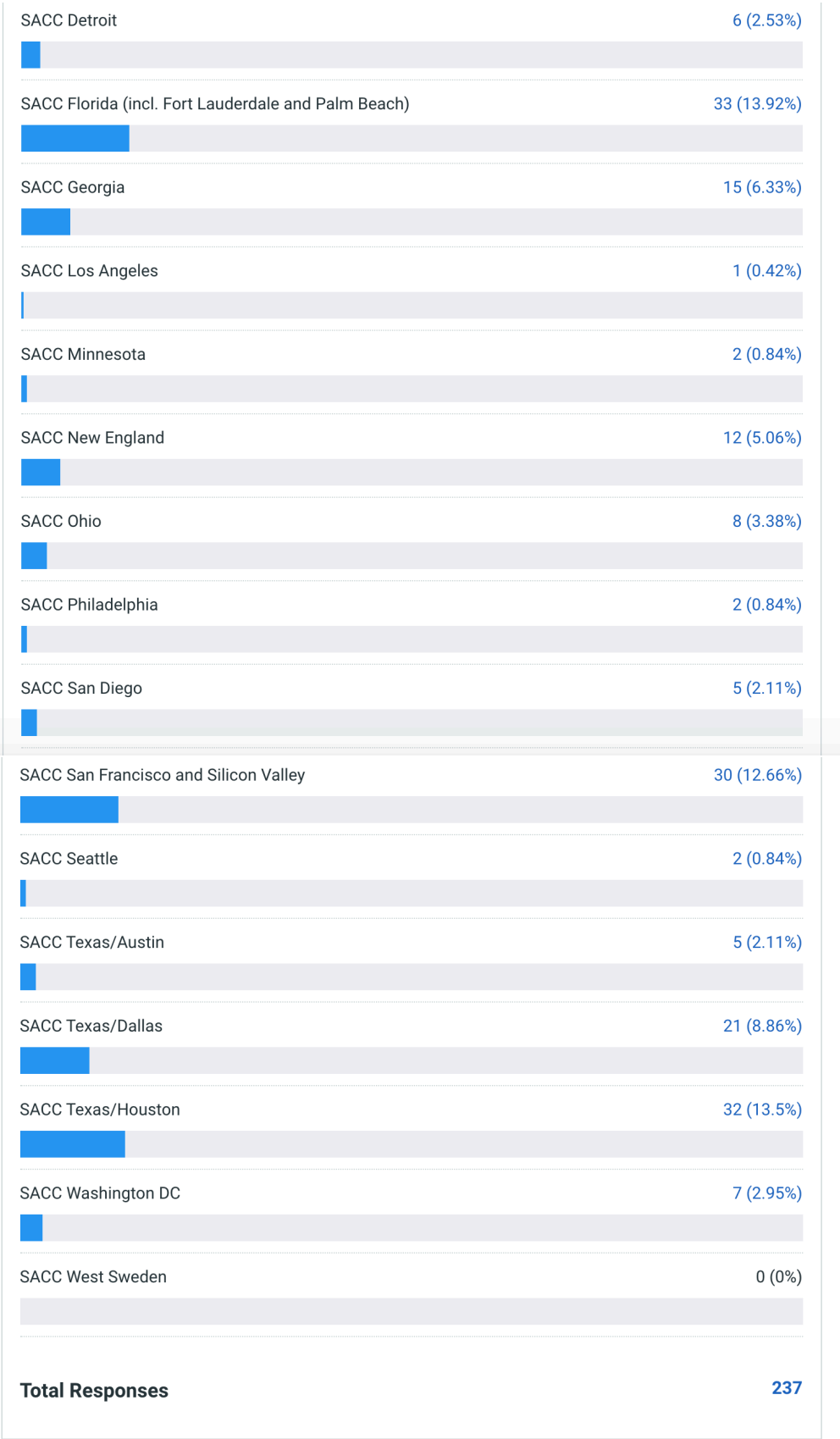

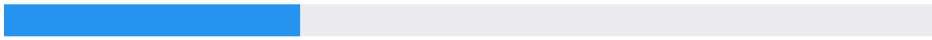

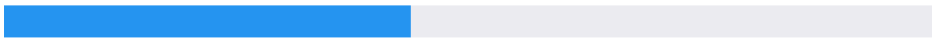
**1. Do you think that lifting of the US travel restrictions in November 2021 will increase business travel between Sweden and the US?**

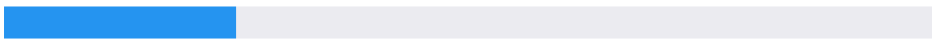
Yes, business travel will be back at the same level as pre-covid during 2022 75 (31.65%)

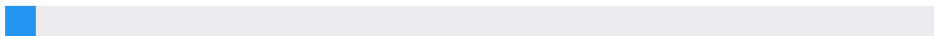
**2. What do you think will be the main reason why some people will choose NOT to business travel, after the restrictions have been lifted?**

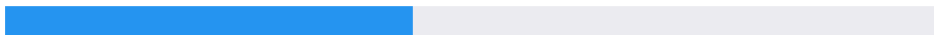
Not doing business travel is the new normal and saves money 126 (53.16%)

For health reasons and continued uncertainty about travel restrictions 103 (43.46%)



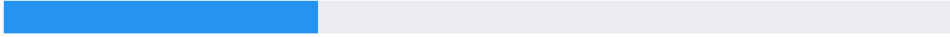

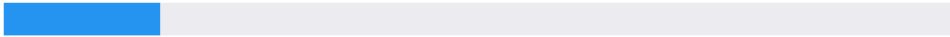
Yes, many Swedish companies have been waiting for the travel restrictions to be lifted to do that 78 (32.91%)

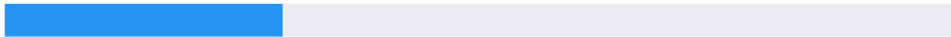

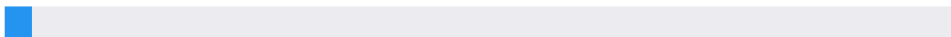
Yes, business travel is good for business 69 (29.11%)

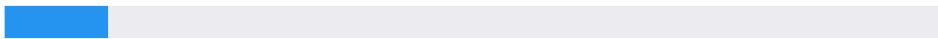
### 5. Do you think that an increase in business travel will also increase business between USA and Sweden?

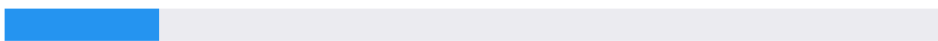
Yes, that will mean an increase in business activity between Sweden and USA 172 (72.57%)

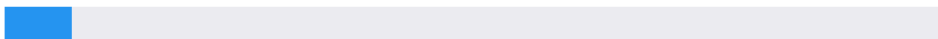

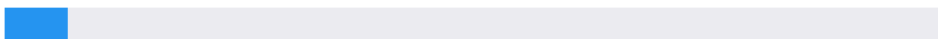

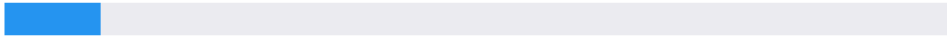
**1. Do you think that Swedish Interns/Trainees on site in the US can contribute to a two-way knowledge exchange, both learning from and contributing to a US organization?**

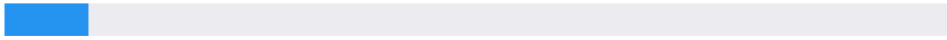
Yes, Swedish Interns/Trainees can contribute to knowledge exchange 192 (81.01%)

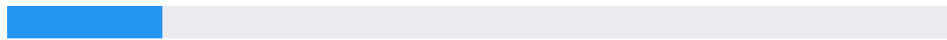

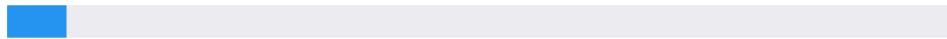

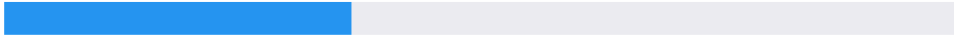

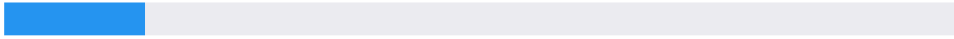
Many organizations hardly knows that the possibility exists 86 (36.29%)

Organizations who work with Interns and Trainees already have internal recruitment and talent programs in place 35 (14.77%)



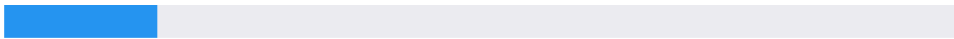

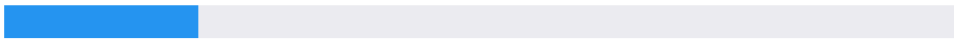

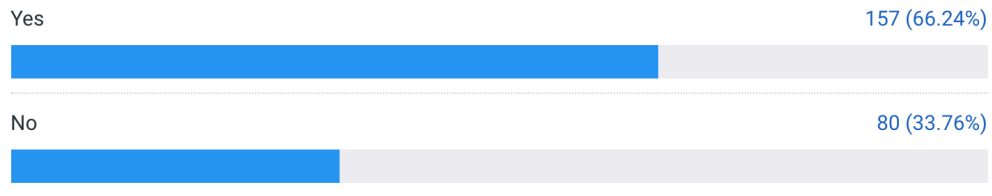
